#### Request for clarification/ Amendment:

As the tender is opened for open international bidding, it is essential to consider the fairness and equality of opportunities for all eligible international bidders. The existing clause regarding the "Margin of Preference", while intended to protect domestic/Saudi bidders, may inadvertently disadvantage eligible international bidders and hinder their interests. Therefore, we kindly request that this specific clause be deleted from the tender requirements in order to ensure a fair and equitable bidding process for all parties involved.
