

Invitation for Bids (IFB)

Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a web-based eGovernment Gazette and Online Library Information System (Open-Source Solution)

1. The **Government Printing Department** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders of **Mauritian Nationals or entities incorporated in Mauritius (Joint Ventures / Consortium are not allowed), for the Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a web-based e-Government Gazette and Online Library Information System for the Government Printing Department.**
2. Bidding will be conducted using the **Open Advertised Bidding** and is open to all eligible Bidders that meet the following minimum qualification criteria: **key qualification criteria relating to previous experience, financial capacity, etc., from the BDS entry for ITB Clause 7.1 (a).**
3. Other details of the requirements and conditions are contained in the bid documents.
4. Any clarifications sought by any bidder in respect of the items to be procured shall be addressed in writing to the Government Printer, Government Printing Department, La Tour Koenig, Pointe-aux-Sables. Bids in sealed envelopes clearly marked **“Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a web-based e-Government Gazette and Online Library Information System (Open Source Solution)” ONB/PRG/PROC/26/25-26** and indicating the closing date should be addressed to the Government Printer, and deposited in the **Tender Box**, situated at the undermentioned address, on or before **Thursday 05 March 2026** up to 13:00 hours (local time), at latest.
