The Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund (SILWF), a parastatal body falling under the aegis of the Ministry of Gender Equality and Family Welfare, intends to rent a building of space area of approximately 150-200 m² to be used as a Community Centre at **(i) Glen Park, Vacoas** and **(ii) La Lucie Roy, Bel Air Rivière Seche** respectively for an initial period of two (2) years and which may be renewed thereafter through mutual agreement between parties.

The proposed Office Space/ Building should be of reinforced concrete on the ground floor. The building should comprise, inter alia, of an open area, one (1) office space, toilet facilities (Male and Female separately), parking facilities for at least 3 vehicles, one (1) kitchen and a store room.
